Partnering with The Book of Hope ministries

After the first few presentations of the Khmer Hope Video, we began to realize that there are many young children that would be better served through a gospel message video made specifically for them. Amazingly in less than one week God introduced us to

an organization that just started a video ministry for young children! They are sponsored by the International Christian Assembly, and they have a wonderful video produced by the Book of Hope in the Khmer language. So after only a short meet-

ing both our ministries agreed to a partnership, and it has been a blessing seeing the children come to know the Lord.



The Mercy Medical Center

The Mercy Medical Clinic was started to proclaim the love of Christ to people of Cambodia through excellent healthcare.

The clinic was established in 2000 as The CSI Clinic. Many Cambodians have poor health caused from unsanitary conditions and malnutrition. The UN reports only 16 physicians for every 1,000,000 people in Cambodia. The physicians are limited by poor facilities, in-

adequate training and low medical standards. The Clinic is also being used as a teaching center for Cambodian Interns. While the patients are waiting, "The Hope Video" is shown.
